



Redwood Raks Collective Scholarship Request Form

The Redwood Raks Collective Scholarship Fund helps dancers and musicians with financial need participate in dance and music classes and events. We want EVERYONE to have access to these opportunities! We hope and expect that experiences provided through scholarship assistance will result in increased or enhanced participation in community activities.

Scholarship funds come from individual donations and fund-raising activities. Scholarships depend on availability of funds.

Scholarships may be requested for the following:

- to help students participate in Raks Collective classes and events
- to help teachers and leaders at the Raks attend workshops or events to bring back material to share
- to help bring specialists from out of the area to present workshops at Redwood Raks

Requirements:

- Request form must be complete, legible, and contain correct contact information.
- Each person requesting funds should fill out a separate form.
- Requests must be submitted **at least one week in advance of the start** of an event or fixed-length class session to allow the Scholarship Committee time to review the request. Requests for ongoing classes may request funding for a specific number of classes.
- If you have received a scholarship in the past, we are happy to provide additional financial support, but ask that you offer a little time to help out the organization.

Note: Funding will be given to the teacher or event coordinator, (rather than cash to the requester.)
